- 3. Survey, find, choose, preserve, digitize and publish a significant set of historical archives that illustrate American Samoa's 125th Quasquicentennial Flag Day Anniversary of 2025 and, the Nation's 250th Semiquincentennial Anniversary in 2026.
- 4. Share U.S. National Archives NHPRC federal grant opportunities and ASHRAB/NHPRC process
- 5. Outline Government Agency and Community Archives Finding Guide objectives to create
 - a. Bilingual finding guides to Territorial Registrar, Archives, High Court and other ASG agencies
 - b. Public guides to ASG archives more than 90 yrs. old. held at the ASG Office of Archives OARM and to public records more than 25 yrs. old.
 - c. Finding Guides to online digitized ASG archives from 1843-1966 and opportunities to transcribe English and Samoan documents found therein by individuals or crowd sourcing transcriptions
 - d. Finding Guides to public records held by local private Church Archives, Businesses, Organizations...
